Dear APHA Executive Board members,

We call on you to show leadership for integrity and public health.

Tobacco kills more than 8 million people a year. 80% of the deaths are in low and middle income countries. The tobacco industry is the key cause of this continuing epidemic of death. It carries out aggressive, multi-million dollar campaigns to addict new generations of youngsters to tobacco, particularly in racialized and low income populations. The tobacco industry works ceaselessly to sabotage effective public health regulations.

182 countries therefore ratified the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control. The Convention requires that countries reject any engagement or collaboration with the tobacco industry or organizations funded by the tobacco industry.

The American Public Health Association has, to date, not supported this landmark public health Convention.

We call on the American Public Health Association to join with the World Federation of Public Health Associations and leading public health organizations in the United States and around the world and support the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control and reject any engagement or collaboration with the tobacco industry or organizations funded by the tobacco industry.

We urgently await your response.
